Headwaters is a commercial business. There is no benefit to the Caledon Tennis Club for HW to join the league. It could be a huge 	

	<p>impact on the Orangeville club, and future impacts on other clubs</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ There is a risk that in the future CTC would lose members to HW. ○ Removes incentive of members of Headwaters to join their community club so they can play competitive tennis on Thursday nights. ○ If Headwaters got a team, it would make CE and Orangeville regaining their individual teams problematic. ○ Concern that most of the stronger players currently and in the future, are also members of Headwaters. Headwaters could end up with a very powerful team if these strong players decided to leave their community clubs and play for Headwaters instead. It would save them money, especially the younger members. By joining Headwaters they would be able to play competitive tennis Tuesday (Intercounty) and Thursday (interclub).
