Tennis with Joanne Phang (Club Pro):

Joanna our Tennis Pro will organize the Junior Tennis Program again. The School Tennis starts in April, Caledon Central School is on board. Alton Elementary School has yet to be confirmed. Flyers will be a different colour in order to keep track of the new registrations specific to the Schools Families. **Phil Staite will print the Flyers off this year.**

Due to last year's lack of attendance 'Cardio Tennis will be offered at other clubs as well as Caledon. The Executive is in agreement that **Joanna has the go ahead to offer an Interclub singles ladder**, therefore other people will be able to play, Orangeville already has a ladder on line, which will be used for the interclub ladder.

Junior Round Robin Tennis will be offered to all of the clubs that Joanna is affiliated with. Tennis for Junior's starts in May.

The Executive has agreed to provide free lessons (4) for junior membership, and/or Juniors who are part of a Family membership. These will be held in May. JoAnna will be paid \$400 for these lessons.

Last year Tennis for Kids cost the CTC \$1080, the previous year the amount was \$1,815.

The Town of Caledon:

The Town of Caledon has given the club \$500 the suggestion was made to have **Joanna send a thank you letter with Photos and Information so that the Town** can see what we are doing with the funds allocated. There are two new signs from the 'Town of Caledon,' one will be placed closer to the road, and one by the Tennis courts. Thanks Terry reminding the Town again last year that we needed new signs! The Town has been asked by the club president to replace the door opposite the courts due to a faulty lock. The Town of Caledon will be asked to put up the Windscreens for a fee of over \$500.
